Items Supplied:

Gnome Body - 3" x 5" coloured paper
Gnome Hat – 3.5 " x 3.5' coloured paper
Gnome Beard – white oval paper

Items needed:

4" cardboard tube (size does not need to be exact), like a toilet paper roll, paper towel roll or wrapping paper roll (cut to size)
Scissors
Glue
Marker

Instructions:

1. Wrap the larger piece of paper around the cardboard tube and glue closed
2. Attach the beard to the tube to form the beard
3. With the marker, draw on the eyes and nose on the cardboard tube and the mouth on the white "beard"
4. Roll the 3.5" square piece of paper so there is point at one end and a point at the tail. Glue along one edge and press firmly.
5. With the scissors, cut the tail off so the rolled paper resembles a cap
6. Apply glue to the top of the cardboard tube
7. Please the cap on top and press lightly.

Options:

1. Use other coloured materials such as felt and material
2. Instead of the paper beard, use cotton pads
3. Add embellishments with whatever supplies you have at home like stickers, beads, pom poms, glitter
